Below are tracks of music which complement each emoji. See if you can guess which piece of music goes with each emoji. Ask a parent/carer or older sibling to search for these tracks on Spotify, YouTube or another music streaming service. If they can make a playlist, that will help with the game. Whilst you listen to the music see how it makes you want to move, e.g. for the scared emoji you could be a scary dragon or ogre.

Choose which emoji you want to dance to first and ask your parent/carer or older sibling to play the music for 20-30 seconds. Try and do this for all the emoji's.

Then your parent/carer or older sibling will choose for you but will not tell you which emoji they have chosen. They will play the music and you will have to quickly guess which one it is and start dancing.

You could swap over. You choose the music and watch your parent/carer or older sibling dance to the music.
