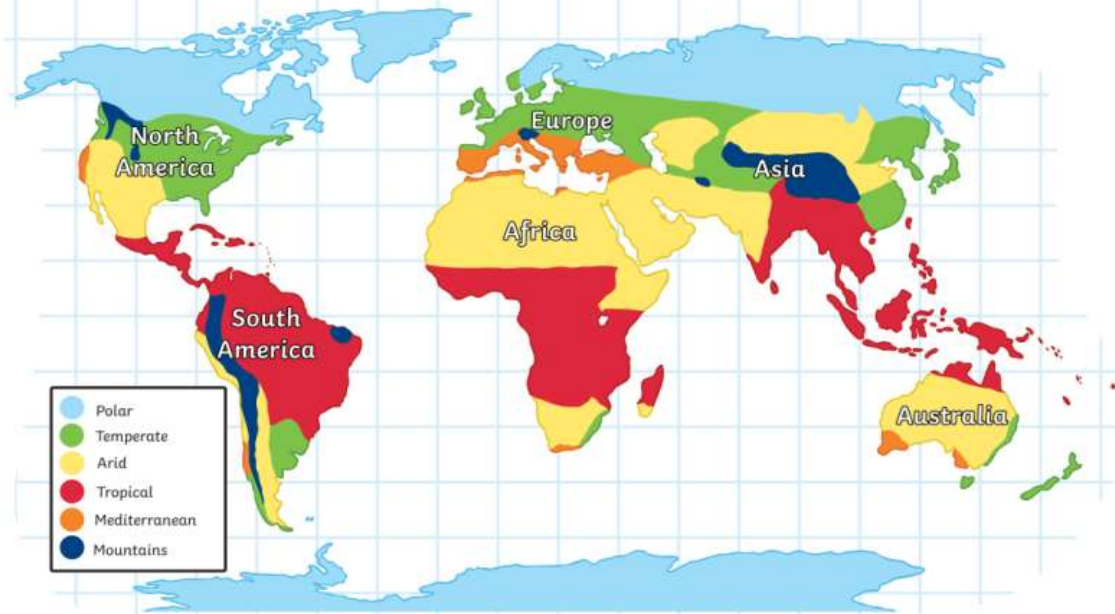
## Key knowledge

Polar Climate	Very cold and dry all year round.	Antarctica
Temperate Climate	Cold winters and mild summers.	United Kingdom
Tropical climate	Hot and wet all year round.	Brazil
Arid (Desert) Climate	Dry and hot all year round.	Sahara Desert

## Key Vocabulary

Climate	The average weather condition over a long period of time.
Weather	Weather changes daily and it is the temperature and conditions for the day.
Location	Where something is. You can use a map to locate countries.
Wildlife	Animals. The wildlife is different across the different climate zones.
Equator	An imaginary line around the middle of the planet. Places near the equator will have the hottest climate.
