**There are three tables, which include results from:-**

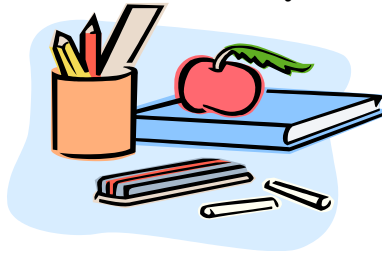
- a Phonics Screening Check for children in Year 1

**I have also included a table which shows progress measures in reading, writing and mathematics.**

As you can see, the results for Bousfield in all three assessments exceed both the RBKC and national results. The Department for Education analyses the national results and produces extensive reports for each school. These reports enable schools to compare both the achievements and progress of their children with other schools.
